By this petition filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Though the quantity of the contraband stated to have been recovered from the petitioner (as per the case of the prosecution) is well above the commercial quantity, he however having been in custody for the past 7 ½ months, with not even one prosecution witnesses out of the nine having been examined so far, and no other case shown to be registered him, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, it is made clear that nothing observed will be taken to be a comment on the merits of the case, which would be gone into by the

trial court wholly on appraisal of the evidence led before it.
