Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation but did not cooperate. He further submits that the vehicle in question i.e. Toyota Innova which is registered in the name of a private limited company managed by father of the petitioner has not been handed over, although, the petitioner had received Rs.5,00,000/- as down payment vide writing dated 20.04.2017.

In view thereof, the petitioner is not found entitled to grant relief of anticipatory bail which can only be granted in extraordinary circumstances.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
