Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.91 dated 22.10.2018 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506, 377 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated November 27, 2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. She further states that as directed by this Court vide order dated 31.01.2019, petitioner has cleared the arrears of maintenance amount.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balbir Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that recovery of three gold ear-

rings, six rings and one kitty-set have been recovered, whereas learned counsel for the complainant states that recovery of more jewellery is yet to be effected from the petitioner. She further states that as observed by this Court vide order dated February 27, 2019, required disciplinary action has already been initiated against ASI Nirmal Singh for making wrong statement before this Court on 31.01.2019.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In the absence of any bills to support the contention made by learned counsel for the complainant but considering the fact that since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated November 27, 2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
