FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 24.07.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Kuldeep Singh and Kamlesh Rani and complainant Preeti, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been

hailed up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 49 dated 10.06.2017 registered at Police Station Women Ludhiana under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
