Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case bearing No.40 dated 30.04.2015, registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 452, 354, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC').

None has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent despite service.

It has been submitted that petitioner has been summoned in pursuance to order dated 06.01.2017 (Anneuxre P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur. Petitioner has already been joined the proceedings and granted interim bail.
