In the present writ petition, the claim which is being raised by the petitioner is that his pay should have been fixed as Rs. 680/- as on 02.01.1978 in terms of Clarification, which was issued by the respondent-department on 30.05.2003 (Annexure P-3) and further to grant consequential benefits of the revision of the pay and the pensionary benefits.

Petitioner argues that whosoever has approached this Court, has been extended the said benefit and the similarly situated employees like the petitioner, are being forced to approach this Court claiming the same relief.

Petitioner prays that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, he has made a representation dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-13) to the respondents and he will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-13) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
