Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No. 2193 of 2013 dated 26.11.2013, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and summoning order dated 26.11.2013 vide which the petitioner and four others have been summoned to face trial for offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contended that petitioner was not the partner in the firm, rather she retired from partnership on the basis of retirement deed executed in the year 2011.

Learned counsel representing the respondent placed reliance upon document Annexure R-1 which he had obtained under RTI Act from Deputy Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Faridabad indicating that

Bhupinder Kaur was partner of 50% in the partnership firm and the partnership firm continue till the date of issuance of the information to the applicant under the RTI Act.

In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed.
