Reply by way of short affidavit of Balkar Singh Bhullar, Superintendent, New District Jail, Nabha, on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 3 filed in Court today is taken on record.

Heard.

Petitioner has impugned the order dated 15.1.2019 (Annexure P-2), passed by District Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib-respondent No. 2 vide which prayer of the petitioner for release on parole to meet his family members was declined.

The reply filed by the State shows that while in jail another FIR No. 101 dated 22.6.2019, under Sections 302, 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code was registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha against the petitioner in which person accused of sacrilege in the State was murdered in the full view of the jail inmates.

It being so and considering the alleged conduct of the petitioner, it is not justified that the petitioner should be enlarged on parole.

Dismissed.
