Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.216 dated 01.08.2018, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 473 of IPC and Section 61 of the Excise Act, registered at Police Station Parao, Ambala Cantt.

Learned State counsel contended that in terms of order dated 15.12.2018 and earlier order dated 26.11.2018, the petitioner has not joined the investigation and as such, the present anticipatory bail is not maintainable and the same be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner had joined the investigation on 26.11.2018 and the police was asking for some documents which were not in his possession.

In view of the above, this Court is of the view that relief of interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner vide order dated

26.11.2018. However, he had chosen not to comply with the orders passed

by this Court and as such, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail and the same stands dismissed.
