Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of the compromise entered into between the parties.

Vide order dated 22.11.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their statements with regard to compromise/settlement within a period of 30 days thereafter. However, as per office report, report of the trial Court is still awaited.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, submits that no statement in support of the compromise has been recorded before the trial Court.

A perusal of the record shows that the petitioners have availed off as many as three opportunities to get the statements of the parties recorded but they did not appear before the trial Court.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioners to file afresh in case the parties acknowledge the compromise in future.
