The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, Police Station Nathana District Bathinda, submits that petitioners in consequence of order dated 26.11.2018 has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and does not oppose the grant of bail.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 26.11.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
