This order shall dispose of the above mentioned two petitions.

These two petitions are in a sense counter blast to each other

while **CRM-M-51685-2018** is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.675 dated 26.10.2015 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/406/506/120-B IPC at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar while **CRM-M-4153-2018** has been filed by the complainant of that FIR praying for a direction for impartial investigation in the same FIR.

In the bail application the petitioner was granted interim bail on 26.11.2018 which is continuing till today. In the direction petition the State has filed a reply stating that challan has been filed against the other two co-accused and challan shall be filed against the third accused (the petitioner in **CRM-M-51685-2018**).

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner in **CRM-M-51685-2018**.

Resultantly, the petitions are allowed. The interim order dated 26.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and as far as the direction petition bearing **CRM-M-4153-2018** is concerned the police is directed to expedite the challan against the petitioner in **CRM-M-51685-2018**.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
