This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 14.07.2017 registered under Sections 326/452/324/506/427/34 IPC at Police Station Ramdas, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that no settlement was possible.

Deputy Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Lakha Singh states that the anticipatory bail of similarly situated co-accused was rejected by this Court.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide their bail

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrender before the court on or before 18.02.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 21.02.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
