Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in Complaint case COMP
No. 539 of 2016 dated 19.01.2016, under Section 138 of the Negotiable
Instruments Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner
had been erroneously declared as proclaimed person as the case was initially
filed at Ludhiana and was transferred to Panchkula. It was again transferred
from Panchkula to Ludhiana and due to the change of place, the petitioner
could not appear before the trial court as he had also noted down the wrong
date.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated
27.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court
and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim
bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner

has appeared before the trial court on 30.05.2019 and has been granted

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interim bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that thereafter, petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial court on each and every date.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 27.05.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall henceforth, appear before the trial court on each and every date and shall not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
