Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 146 dated 12.10.2018, under Sections 307/341/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 26.11.2018:-

“It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that as per allegations in the FIR, no injury has been attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 28.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

HC Gurmail Singh, who is present in the Court, has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 26.11.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The aforesaid observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
