Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.168 dated 15.03.2018, under Sections 148,149,379-B (subsequently deleted) and Sections 323,506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (added) registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad, Haryana.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 03.12.2018 :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner have already been released on bail and the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings.

Learned State counsel seeks time to verify the role of the petitioner.

Adjourned to 23.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”
