The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.70 dated 14.03.2019, under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioners are that they have snatched the purse containing mobile phone and other articles of the complainant. He, however, contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated and the complainant in her deposition before the Court has not supported the prosecution case qua the petitioners. Learned counsel has furnished a copy of the deposition of the complainant which is taken on record. He further contends that the petitioners are not involved in any other case and are in custody for over six months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Karam Singh, states that only the complainant has been examined out of 19 prosecution witnesses. He is not in a position to controvert the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner that the complainant has turned hostile.

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Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when the complainant has turned hostile, the petitioners are in custody for over six months, they are not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
