The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.224 dated 12.09.2018 registered under Sections 379-B(2), 411, 323 IPC (Section 452 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station A-Division, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the case against the petitioners is totally concocted. There is no evidence against the petitioners; to connect them to the alleged crime. Even the complainant, while appearing as witness before the trial Court, has not supported the case of the prosecution. There is no other case against the petitioners. The petitioners are in custody since 12.09.2018. They are not required for any investigation purposes in this case.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel, being assisted by HC Manohar Lal, submits that the petitioners are involved in the case. However, it is not disputed that even the complainant has not supported the case of the prosecution. It is also not disputed that there is no other case against the petitioners.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further upon

merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
