Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to get FIR No.74 dated 17.08.2018 under Section 354 IPC, registered at Police Station Bahawala investigated by some senior police officer and further to add offence under Sections 323, 452, 34 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act), 1989 and also to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Manjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural) Abohar, District Fazilka, has already been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. As per affidavit, after completing the investigation, the police has prepared the challan in the FIR and the

same is likely to be presented in the court in near future. The reply further suggests that the plea of the petitioner that private respondent Nos.4 to 8 were also involved for the commission of crime and they have committed the offence punishable under Sections 323, 452, 34 IPC and Section 3 of the SC & ST Act has been found false and baseless.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the police has already investigated the matter and prepared the challan in the FIR in question, which is likely to be presented in the court, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to submit the investigation report within a period of one month from today.

On furnishing such investigation report, the petitioner if aggrieved has a right to agitate in accordance with law.
