Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0070 dated 04.03.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC with Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 23.05.2019, while issuing notice of motion in the case, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Pursuant thereto, a report has been received from the Mediator that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement, vide settlement/agreement dated 26.08.2019. The said settlement/agreement shall form part of the record.

In view of the settlement so arrived at between the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the presence of

the petitioner is required in the case in any manner by the police, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to him to avail the remedies permissible under the law.
