The writ petition filed with a prayer to revise and re-fix the pay scale of the deceased husband of the petitioner was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to look into the legal notice dated 20.07.2018 and needful was to be done within three months from the receipt of the copy of the order. The present contempt petition is filed pleading that the directions of this Court has not been complied with.

Pursuant to the notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Vikas Garg, IAS, Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh dated 12.09.2019 was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed, the only dispute remains with regard to the revised pension and

remaining gratuity amount.

Learned State counsel placed reliance upon Annexure R-4 annexed with the reply whereby the pension has been revised and it has been found that the amount of Rs. 61,479/- is to be paid to the petitioner as a result of revised Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity. He submits that petitioner is advised to contact District Treasury Officer, Ferozpur, for receiving the payment.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition, the same is disposed of. However, there is no doubt that in case, the petitioner approaches the District Treasury officer, Ferozpur and completes the formalities, the amount would be disbursed immediately thereafter.
