This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 29.6.2018 registered under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at police station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the FIR the petitioner and her husband were found sitting and the alleged recovery was made from a bag and both of them are now in custody. As regards the petitioner, she has been in custody for more than 6 months and no other case is pending against her.

Custody certificate dated 21.2.2019 by way of affidavit of Gurcharan Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Prison, Patiala has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. The custody

certificate corroborates the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for 6 months and 12 days and her antecedents are clean.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Bhola Singh has accepted that husband of the petitioner is in custody.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
