ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 14.06.2018, under Sections 420, 506, 342, 24 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sherpur, Police District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a monetary dispute and the matter has been compromised with the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the matter has indeed been compromised on 17.05.2019.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 28.11.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on

ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 28.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
