Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the appointment of a Warrant Officer with a direction to get the detenu, namely, Sapna Devi released, who is stated to have been illegally picked up by respondent No.4-Sunil Kumar.

The alleged detenu-Sapna Devi, who has been identified by Sub Inspector Dinesh Kumar along with Lady Constable Jyoti, Police Station Samalkha, Panipat, has made statement that respondent No.4-Sunil

Kumar is her legitimate and legal husband and she has come along with him today, in the Court and wants to reside and live with him as his wife and undergo all her obligations arriving out of this relationship.

The lady has denied having any relations with petitioner-Surender Singh, and has accompanied respondent No.4-Sunil Kumar, who is present in the Court and identified by the police officials.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has made statement withdrawing the present petition and stating that ₹20,000/-, so ordered to be deposited vide orders dated 21.05.2019 by this Court, be given to Sapna Devi and has no objection to that.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has paid ₹20,000/-, in cash, to Sapna Devi, who has received the same of her entire satisfaction.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
