Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for challenging the order dated 04.05.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby the prayer for extension of time for surrendering before the trial Court and for furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds was declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 05.04.2019 and a period of ten days was granted to surrender before the trial Court. According to him, the requisite bail bonds could not be arranged and therefore, the petitioners did not surrender before the trial Court.

To a pointed query, learned counsel for the petitioners responded that the petitioners may surrender within next ten days before the trial Court in compliance of the order dated 05.04.2019.

It is apparent that the petitioners are uncertain about their

intention to comply with the order dated 05.04.2019, therefore, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, petition is dismissed.
