This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation Jalandhar to take action on the legal notice dated 13.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) sent by the petitioner to decide the complaints filed by the petitioner pending before respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation Jalandhar to consider and decide the legal notice dated 13.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Ms. Samina Dhir, D.A.G., Punjab, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner, Municipal Corporation Jalandhar to consider and decide the legal notice dated 13.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the prayer made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the prayer made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
