Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.196 dated 29.12.2014 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 07.12.2018: -

“.....Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, one Prem Singh has sought information under the RTI Act about the death certificate of one Dana Singh, as petitioner-Gurmeet Kaur, being daughter of Jarnail Singh, had applied for death certificate of Dana Singh showing herself his daughter. It is further stated that the concerned M.C-Gurmeet Kaur had attested the report on the application given by the petitioner. Counsel further submits that in fact the petitioner has never applied for obtaining the death certificate of Dana Singh and the primary allegations levelled by Prem Singh are against

M.C.-Gurmeet Kaur that she has attested the report on the application given by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the petitioner be directed to join investigation only to know about the reason for which she applied for the death certificate.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
