In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.0063 dated 25.04.2019 under Sections 452, 325, 323, 506, 120-B and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City-I Mansa, District Mansa.

2 This Court vide order dated 06.06.2019 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3 Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bikramjit Singh, Police Station City-I Mansa states that in pursuance of the order dated 06.06.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and that he is not required for further custodial interrogation.

4 In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of case, the order dated 06.06.2019, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5 However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6 Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
