Grievance of the petitioners is that due to implementation of the Fifth Pay Commission, Government of Punjab qua Assured Career Progression Scheme (A.C.P.Scheme), their juniors are getting more salary than them. In the premise, the petitioners submitted representation with the respondents as reflected from Annexure P-7 but the same was not adverted by the respondents. A legal notice dated 28.01.2015 (Annexure P-2) was also served through their counsel but to no avail. Hence, the writ petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 28.01.2015 and representation dated 10.05.2019 (Annexures P-2 and P-7 respectively) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking

order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
