The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.613 dated 11.10.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 354-A(3), 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 67 of Information & Technology Act, at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has been settled before the District Legal Services Authority, Jind. He further submits that the complainant has refused to accept ₹ 25,000/- as per order dated 1.3.2019.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 27.11.2018 is made absolute till the

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
