Reply by Sultan Singh, DSP (HQ), Ambala City has been filed.

Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 37 dated 5.2.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Ambala City.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner had cheated the first informant for a sum of Rs. 10 lakhs in order to get a distributorship of Patanjali Ayurved Limited. Petitioner is in custody since 18.2.2019.

As per the information supplied by the learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, petitioner is involved in another FIR at Noida.

Case is triable by Magistrate. Investigations are complete.

Trial of the case has started. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is stated to be a resident of Village Panchi, P.S.Shekhupur Sarai, District Shekhnपुरa, Bihar, therefore, the Court would direct the petitioner to furnish adequate local surety to secure his presence.

Petition stands allowed.
