Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition, but at the same time, respondent No.2 be directed to cooperate with the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 127 Cr.P.C. He further submits that initially respondent No.2 was avoiding service and lastly she has refused to accept notice and in this manner, proceedings under Section 127 Cr.P.C. are unnecessarily been delayed by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that she has no information so far as petition filed by the petitioner under Section 127 Cr.P.C.
