Accused petitioners Joginder Singh, Veer Kaur, Mandeep Singh and Pawanpreet Kaur, have sought quashment of the FIR bearing No.54 dated 16.06.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 498-A, 313, 406, 494, 120B IPC pertaining to Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural got registered by private respondent No.2 Paramjit Kaur.

Upon appreciating the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioners Mr.Dhruv Gupta, Advocate and in the light of records, there are serious allegations levelled by the complainant against the accused for colluding in deceiving the complainant by means of impersonation in getting the complainant married to one of the accused and thereafter, raising demand of more dowry and on that pretext physically and mentally torturing the complainant. The allegations also harbor around forcible abortion of the complainant twice against her wishes by the

accused in advancing their dubious plan against her. The contentions that the petitioners have not been attributed any specific role being mere relatives, are questions of evidence which can be answered only at the time of trial and in view of the law laid down in ‘**State of Haryana and others v. Ch.Bhajan Lal and others**’ 1992 AIR SC 604, no case for showing interference at this juncture is made out. The petition thus stands dismissed in limine.
