Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.0028 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

In compliance to the order dated 28.11.2018, report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Derabassi has been received that the parties have been effected into compromise which is genuine, voluntary and without any undue pressure or threat.

In view of the matter, continuation of proceedings before the trial Court is useless exercise. Accordingly, FIR No.0028 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioners.
