Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.116 dated 11.10.2018 under Sections 452, 326, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, following order was passed on 28.11.2018: -

*“.....Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in fact there is a civil dispute regarding a residential property. Learned counsel submits that both the petitioners are house wives and have been falsely implicated in the case whereas the injuries are attributed to one Wassan Singh. Learned counsel further submits that even a cross-version has been registered against the complainant party and the petitioners are ready to join the investigation.....”*

The Investigating Officer, who is present in the Court, has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation. It is further stated that the parties have compromised the matter and they have already filed a petition praying for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 28.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
