Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.531 dated 20.08.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 379-B, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that

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though the petitioner was named in the F.I.R., but no injury has been

attributed to the present petitioner, rather the same have been attributed to other accused persons and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation as well.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Virender, opposed the petition for pre-arrest bail on the ground that the petitioner is the main accused in this case who is named in the F.I.R. and his other associates caused injuries including pistol injury.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for both the sides and the facts that the petitioner was specifically named in the F.I.R. and he alongwith his associates had caused injuries including pistol injury, no case is made out for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and the present petition is dismissed.
