Present petition is for under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Suraj Kumar son of Ashok Kumar in case FIR No.601 dated 26.12.2016 under Section 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66-D of the Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Kherki Daula, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. Co-accused Dinesh has already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 10.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-19463-2019. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars any more, so, he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel affirmed the period of custody of the petitioner and the fact the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.08.2018, co-accused Dinesh has already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 10.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-19463-2019; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars any more, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Suraj Kumar is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
