Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.112 dated 15.08.2018, under Sections 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Fertilizer Order 7, 28(1)(D) 19(c)(VI) Terms and Conditions (1) Form B and Section 10(3) Rules, 1971 of Insecticide Act, 1968, 7(1)(A)(11) of EC Act registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 30.11.2018 :-

“Learned State counsel seeks some time to have instructions in the matter as to whether the shifting of the godown from Bhaggu Road, Opposite BSNL Qts, Bathinda, Punjab to Village Naruwala, District Bathinda has caused any injury to the public.

Adjourned to 23.01.2019 for further consideration.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv)

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*Cr.P.C. failing which they shall lose the benefit of interim bail
allowed to them.”*

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhola Singh,
has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioners have
joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer
required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 30.11.2018 is made
absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
and the present petition stands disposed off.
