The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 117 dated 22.10.2018 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted interim bail by the trial Court due to non-receipt of FSL report. However, she could not appear before the Court on 18.05.2019, as she was suffering from severe backache and her bail was cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within ten days from today, as she is still suffering from back pain, and prefer an application for regular bail and the trial Court may be directed to decide the same expeditiously.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner may surrender before the trial Court within a period of ten days from today. In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided by the trial Court expeditiously in accordance with law.
