Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.140 dated 02.07.2018 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 13.03.2019. The trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail to the petitioner.

Having considered the submissions by learned counsel for both the sides, this Court is of the considered view that no ground for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out keeping in view the fact that heavy quantity of narcotics was recovered from the possession of the petitioner, which falls under the commercial quantity. Moreso, the petitioner is involved in two more cases under the N.D.P.S. Act.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
