The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are the parents of petitioner No. 1.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms.Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant

petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to take necessary action on the representation dated 20.5.2019 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners and provide necessary protection to the petitioners in accordance with law, in case, he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5.
