Writ petition filed by the petitioner was allowed with direction to grant ex-gratia compensation to the petitioner by treating Sh. Hari Om, husband of the petitioner, as employee of the respondent-department for all intents and purposes.

Pursuant to notice of motion, a short reply by way of affidavits on behalf of the respondents, filed in Court today, is taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

With the reply, there is acknowledgment dated 20.07.2019 whereby the petitioner has received an amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- vide cheque No. 276892 dated 19.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed today in Court, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in

accordance with law for claiming interest for the delayed payment.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
