On 28.5.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No.58 dated 10.03.2019, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

According to the prosecution, in the month of October-November, 2017, petitioner No.2 impersonating himself as Amit son of Mahesh, appeared in physical, medical and written test and petitioner No.1 applied in the army recruitment, on the basis of forged birth certificate to get employed.

Learned counsel contends that both the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the instant case. They are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 29.10.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhim Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 28.5.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
