This order shall dispose of two connected petitions i.e. **CRM-M-52373-2018** titled as **Jatender Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and another** and **CRM-M-52956-2018** titled as **Harbans Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**. For brevity, facts have been taken from CRM-M-52373-2018.

Petitioners seek quashing of DDR No.27 dated 11.10.2018 along

with FIR bearing No.0264 dated 08.10.2018 under Sections 323, 325, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

In compliance to the order dated 28.11.2018, report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar has been received that both the parties have entered into compromise which is without any inducement, coercion or pressure.

In view of the fact that the parties have effected compromise, DDR No.27 dated 11.10.2018 along with FIR bearing No.0264 dated 08.10.2018 under Sections 323, 325, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petitions are accordingly allowed.
