By this common order, two petitions bearing CRM-M-23960
of 2019 and CRM-M-23984 of 2019 shall stand disposed of.

Prayer in both the petitions is to grant regular bail in FIR
No.19 dated 17.01.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 392, 420,
216, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms

Act, 1959, Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

Learned counsels for the petitioner (in both petitions) have submitted that the petitioners have been implicated on the disclosure statement of co-accused and the petitioners were not at the place of incident.

Learned counsels for the petitioner have further relied upon the orders passed in CRM-M-19512-2019 and CRM-M-22919-2019 granting bail to Kapoor @ Goldy and Inderjit Singh @ Gora.

Learned counsel appearing for State of Haryana has submitted that the investigation is complete and the challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioners-Sonu @ Badal and Deepak (in both petitions) are directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
