In the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 to 7, who are relatives petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 21.05.2019 as per Hindu rites and ceremonies. The marriage certificate and photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 02.11.2000 and Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) has been attached showing year of date of birth and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 15.04.1995 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2). It is submitted that the petitioner No.1 is Kati by caste and the petitioner No.2 is Jatt Sikh.

A representation dated 21.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied to her.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in '**Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another**', 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
