Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although FIR No.282 dated 10.09.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Rajpura, Patiala was lodged at the instance of the petitioner but despite a period of about 8 months having been elapsed, no effective investigation has been conducted under the same.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Station House Officer, Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-2)

expeditiously in accordance with law and to ensure that matter is got investigated expeditiously so that a final report be filed thereupon at the earliest.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.2-Station House Officer, Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
