Petitioner is stated to be a senior citizen aged 76 years.

It has been averred that in the year 2011 petitioner had disowned his son as also daughter-in-law.

Counsel submits that the matrimonial relationship between his son and daughter-in-law /respondent no.4 has run into rough weather and resultantly the daughter-in-law as also her immediate relatives are constantly harassing the petitioner and troubling him to take advantage of his old age.

Instant petition has been filed seeking a Mandamus for directing official respondents no.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension to the same at the hands of private respondents.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and having perused the pleadings on record and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.3 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station, Civil Lines, District Amritsar to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
