The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.29 dated 20.03.2018, registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner placed on record photographs as well as Marriage Certificate dated 05.01.2018 issued by a priest of a temple Shiv Mandir Prabhandak Committee, Jandiala, Near Water Tank, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gamdoor Singh, submitted that it has been verified that both petitioner and the complainant have married with each other.

The petitioner is in custody since 02.04.2019. The trial of the

case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Ranjit Singh @ Bittu is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
