INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.137 dated 20.12.2017, registered at Police Station Hariana, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 420, 465, 467 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first petition for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner has already been dismissed on merit vide order dated 10.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-1222-2018 by this Court. There are serious allegations that a fake cheque amounting to ₹5 crore has been presented before the bank in connivance with the present petitioner also. No change in the circumstances has been pointed out for grant of anticipatory bail.

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Therefore, finding no merit in the second petition for anticipatory bail, the same is dismissed.
